The Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) Hearing Officer, Mary Jo Krolewski, will conduct a site visit in this proceeding on **Thursday, January 16, 2020, starting at 1:30 P.M.**

On December 24, 2020, the Petitioners filed a proposed itinerary for the site visit, which the Hearing Officer is adopting. The site visit will begin at Green Mountain Power’s (“GMP”) Lowell Substation. The itinerary for the site visit is as follows:

1:30pm	Meet at GMP Lowell Substation (2337 VT Rte 100, Lowell, VT)
2:00pm	Depart Lowell Substation (15 min travel time)
2:15pm	Arrive at intersection of Mines Rd and VAG Rd, Eden VT - first B20 observation location
2:30pm	Depart VAG Rd (10 min travel time)
2:40pm	Arrive at Eden Sand and Gravel (1738 VT Rte 100, Eden VT) - second B20 observation location
2:55pm	Depart Eden Sand and Gravel (15 min travel time)
3:10pm	Arrive at MWL Cady’s Falls Hydro station – first B22/3319 observation location (Intersection of Duhamel Rd and Cady’s Falls Rd in Morrisville VT)
3:25pm	Depart Cady’s Falls Hydro station to drive along route of B22
3:40pm	Complete site visit upon arrival at MWL #3 (Intersection of Cady’s Falls Rd and Morrystown Corners Rd, Morrisville VT)

Parties and interested persons attending the site visit are requested to meet at GMP Lowell Substation, located at 2337 Route 100 in Lowell, Vermont, promptly at 1:30 P.M.

There is limited parking at the Lowell Substation where the site visit will commence. If adjoining landowners or other members of the public would like to attend the site visit, please contact Kamran Hassan at GMP at 802-353-9950 by January 14, 2020, in order to give GMP time to make any additional parking and/or carpooling arrangements if needed.
