

Office Location and Parking Information

The Vermont Public Utility Commission is located in Montpelier at 112 State Street on the fourth floor of the M&T Bank building. Enter at the rear of the building to the right of the bank entrance (door marked “State Offices”).

ADA-accessible parking is available:

- in the M&T Bank parking lot at 112 State Street;
- behind the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets at 116 State Street;
- in most State employee parking lots in Montpelier.

Vehicles using these spaces must have the appropriate placard displayed to avoid being towed.

OFFICES: The Commission offices, including the Clerk of the Commission and the Commission Conference Room, are on the fourth floor of 112 State Street.

HEARING ROOMS: The Susan M. Hudson Hearing Room is on the third floor of 112 State Street. The adjacent conference room, the Giga Room, which belongs to another agency, the Vermont Department of Public Service, is also used at times. All areas are accessible by elevator and stairs.
