Updates from the PUC [Time Stamp 0:07:40]

[PUC staff straw proposal on credit fulfillment plans and criteria, non-compliance and the waiver process was issued in ePUC yesterday – proposal is not in the scope of TAG work. If commenting as an individual, deadline is 7/29; Window for pacing feedback has closed, TAG should be clear in what it plans to continue addressing under pacing “other considerations” and reconciliation between target and LC emissions (which was addressed in the straw proposal); TAG should advise where in the schedule it would like to consider and recommend statutory changes.]

Updates on subgroups: the credit issue subgroup is focusing on what will become the credit marketplace and the public engagement subgroup is focusing on providing written recommendations to the PUC for public engagement.]

Outstanding Issues for TAG consideration [Time Stamp 1:26:15]

- Pacing straw proposal “other considerations” *[Subgroup will meet next week to detail these concerns for the group and PUC.]*
- Reconciliation between target and lifecycle emissions of CH measures *[Ken is developing a proposal for the group's consideration at the next meeting.]*
- Current year Vs prior year data to establish obligation of delivered fuel *[Matt will work on drafting a proposal for the group's consideration.]*
- Information needed for Preliminary Registry *[Ken raised the importance of this matter but there is no action item for the TAG at this time.]*
- How much CO2e should = 1 credit? *[There seemed to be some preliminary consensus that we don't need to wait to see the ballpark of emissions savings from measure characterizations (or worry about very small fractional credits) and that 1 credit should = 1 metric ton of CO2e. This would be in line with related programs.]*

Public Comments [Time Stamp 2:28:00]

[Public comments included: OD should go over their methodologies and assumptions (including providing the forecast for the grid) before modeling; TAG feedback/comments to OD should be made public; Adding an addendum to the EAG meeting about LIHEAP – that the CHS is designed to increase credit costs over time which will greatly affect LIHEAP's budget.]
